

PARKING ON MS/HS CAMPUS

Due to the Revitalization Project, parking on campus has presented many challenges for everyone this school year. With part of the west lot fenced off, the middle school loop closed and limited access to the maintenance buildings behind the Fitness Center, the number of available parking spaces has been reduced from prior years.

If you drive through any of the parking lots during the day, you may see varying number of empty spaces. This is due to late arrival students, early dismissal students, absent students & staff, midday workers such as the Food Service Department employees, staff members that are shared between buildings and staff members that leave campus for lunch.

There are currently 281 available parking spaces between the high school and the middle school. With 126 staff members between the two buildings, there are 155 spaces that remain available for students, contractors, substitutes, and visitors. To date, we have issued 145 parking tags to students. Seniors were given first priority over the summer, with two subsequent lotteries held for students based upon their application dates. The remaining 10 spaces are used at varying rates by the other groups of people listed above. We also need to account for snow removal, if needed, that occupy several spots depending upon the snow fall.

While we would like to accommodate all student requests, there is simply more demand than we currently have available space. Once the west lot fencing is removed, we will be able to offer additional spaces to students. We do not recommend students parking at St. Martin's. As an alternative, students may park in the spots around Field 12 (baseball field). There is no parking tag or fee needed, but students utilizing this option must walk inside the split-rail fence until they get to the Upper Elementary School as there is no sidewalk between the field and the U.E.S.
